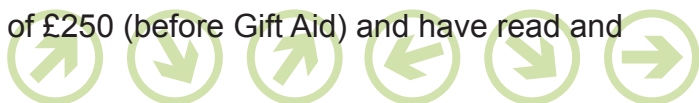

Terms and Conditions

- You must be 18 years or older on the date of the race.
- Retail Trust reserves at its absolute discretion the right to refuse an application.
- By accepting one of our guaranteed places you pledge to raise a minimum of £250 for the charity excluding Gift Aid. In the event you do not raise the pledged amount by the date of the race you will be obliged to continue fundraising until the amount is achieved or to make up the shortfall.
- You agree to pay a £50 non-refundable deposit. This will form part of the pledged funds, however if you are unable to take part in the race, this will not be returned and will be used towards the costs incurred by Retail Trust.
- Retail Trust continues to own each of its places right up to the starting gun. If it looks like you are struggling to raise the required minimum pledge through sponsorship in the lead up to the race, we may advise you not to use the place this year but hold over until the following year. This would allow you a longer run at the fundraising target.
- If you get ill or injured or have a personal problem which requires you to withdraw from the race before the event you will be considered for a place again the following year.
- If you are unable to participate in the run for any reason you must notify Retail Trust immediately and all donated monies collected in support of Retail Trust must be forwarded to the charity immediately or returned to the individual sponsors.
- Monies already received by the charity will not be refunded.
- You cannot use your charity place to raise money for any other organisation or person.
